

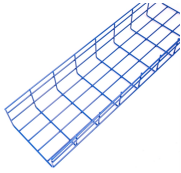
## Calculation of Standard Quota for Distribution Boxes

Calculate quotas, fair-shares, geometric means, and divisors for Jefferson's, Adam's, Webster's, Hamilton's, Hill's, and Equal Proportions methods. Enter State Populations and House Size (Number of Seats) in Green Boxes. States with 0 Lower Quota that automatically receive a seat. ## Calculation of Standard Quota for Distribution Boxes

Hamilton's Method is a mathematical approach for solving problems related to fair division and apportionment.



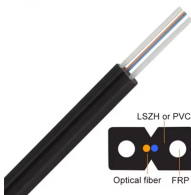

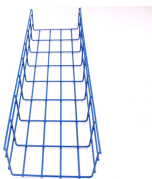
Example: ... Lower Quota: It's the standard quota rounded down to the nearest whole number.
