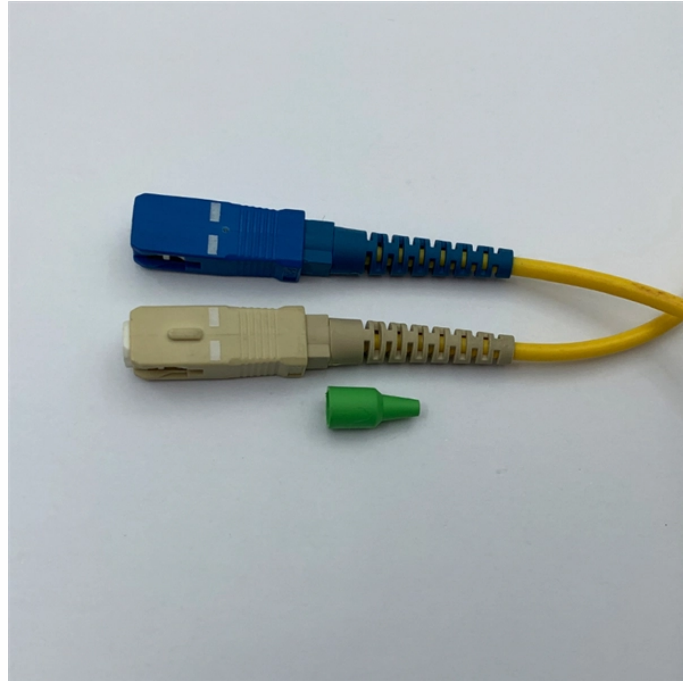


# Congo Tail Fiber Channel Company
