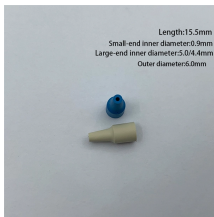
Distribution box circuit number L1



This standard describes requirements for numbering and labeling of real property electrical distribution equipment, circuits, and site lighting at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory.

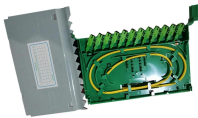

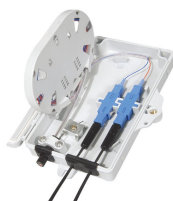
Distribution boards will shift the number of ways as the user adds new circuits e.g. first circuit will be placed on 1.L1 and the second on 1.L2 in a single phase case.



L1, L2, and L3 are used in three-phase systems, which are common in industrial and commercial buildings. Each “L” stands for a Line, meaning a conductor carrying alternating current (AC).

L1 is the first level of power distribution, and it is generally the most basic form. This level typically involves a direct connection between a power source and a device or system, such as an ...

L1 and L2 are relatively common labels in electrical wiring, but they may cause confusion if you've never encountered them. People associate L1 and L2 with 240V systems. They both carry 120V. L1 and L2 ...



Note that the breakers are across both L1 and L2. A tie bar physically connects the two breakers together. Locations 17, 18, 19, and 20 are empty slots and can be used for additional branch circuits. ...
