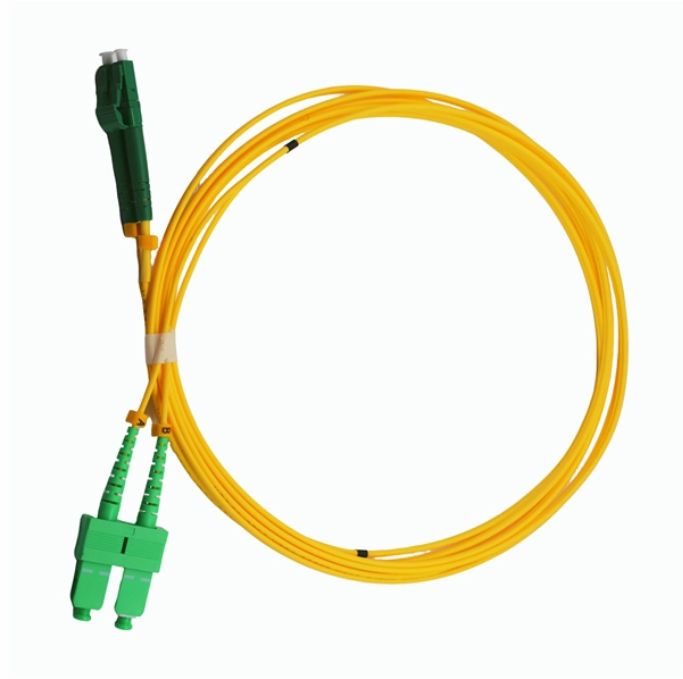

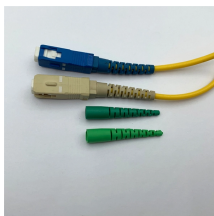
Optical energy is passively split into multiple output signals (fibers), each containing light with properties identical to the original except for reduced amplitude. Because the splitter is a passive device it is ...

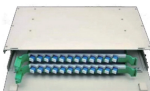
Optical couplers come with different port setups. The most common are N x M couplers. “N” is the number of input ports, and “M” is the number of output ports. For example, a 1x2 coupler ...



Let's start with the simplest type. Shown below is a simple 1X2 splitter with one input and two outputs. Basically, in one direction it splits the signal into 2 parts to couple to two fibers.



Polarizing beamsplitters split incoming light into two orthogonal states. They can also be used to combine the light from two fibers into a single output fiber. When used as a beam combiner, each ...



Fiber optic beam splitters are used to divide light from one fiber into two or more fibers. Light from an input fiber is first collimated, then sent through a beam splitting optic to divide it into two. The ...
