## Fiber splicing technique for leather thread tail



FID AND DIMENSIONS ke the splice easier to perform. Through use and exposure to the elements, the fibers in a used rope have probably lost some of their original strength. In addition, some shrinkage ...



Leather lacing is done primarily in a few basic steps. These include making holes, threading the needle, feeding the lace (which varies based on stitch type), tying off the end, then ...



To splice single-braid, you tuck the end of the rope down the center of the fiber tube. The splice works on the same principle as the Chinese handcuff trick, the tighter the rope is pulled, the more the tube ...



I've looked high and low and can't find a procedure for splicing single loop edge braid on a single layer of leather. There's lots of stuff about splicing on two layers where you bring the tail up ...



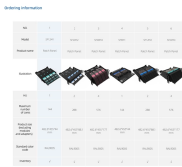

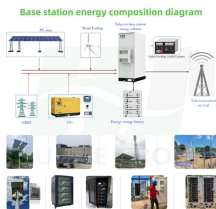
Loose tails simply don't work when you're hand stitching a western holster or saddle that's thicker than most of these people's compete wallets. The needles coming off the tail when you are having to pull ...



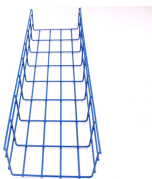
When the job is finished the thread and any knots over the edge you have tied are snipped of. I then use a round awl and push the remnants of the threads I have snipped off back ...

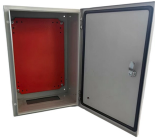
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To splice into a thimble with ears, shackle, or similar item, simply follow the directions of the splicing instructions, using the thimble or shackle bale to determine the eye size.

Mechanical splicing is an optical junction where the fibers are precisely aligned and held in place by a self-contained assembly, not a permanent bond. This method aligns the two fiber ends to ...
