Telecom Fiji has officially launched its Fiber Optic Extension project in Vanua Levu, which aims to significantly enhance high-speed internet access for many Fijians.



Optical Fiber is a transmission medium that uses glass fibers to transmit data in the form of light and it work based on the principle of total internal reflection.



While delivering his address at the Pacific Fiber and Training conference at the Sofitel Fiji Resort and Spa yesterday, Mr Kamikamica said these cables represented more than infrastructure.
