Fireproofing Measures for Cable Trays Galvanized steel, Stainless steel, Fire-resistant coated trays, Flame-retardant plastic composites. Surfaces should be coated with fire-retardant paint to slow flame spread and increase heat.

Scope: Firestopping for busway, cable trays, cables, and trunking passing through walls in enclosed electrical installations. Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with. This document outlines the key requirements for cable tray layout, installation, and fireproofing in industrial and commercial environments. By following these steps, you can enhance durability and comply with national safety requirements. \* Two (2) sticks of moldable putty (part number FSP-MPS) are also needed for each opening.

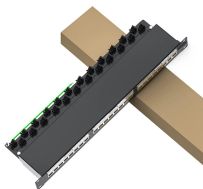
