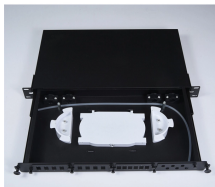
This document establishes a standard to prevent foreign object damage and impact damage to products and hardware being designed, developed, manufactured, assembled, tested, operated, repaired, ...

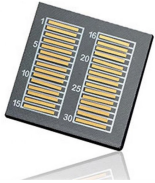
The most commonly cited foreign objects include glass fragments, metal pieces, and plastic fragments, found in various food categories including bakery products, beverages, processed ...



Extraneous foreign material in food products is a physical hazard that must be addressed quickly and in the most detailed manner possible to prevent any other contamination.



Extraneous materials include any foreign matter in a product associated with objectionable conditions or practices in production, storage, or distribution.



Learn about six common foreign body contaminants in food production, including plastic, glass, metal, stone, packaging and PPE.



The key point is that the foreign body is a physical object that should not be present in the product. Foreign bodies include a wide range of potential contaminants of food including plastic, ...



Finding a foreign object in your food can lead to real damages — medical bills, lost wages, and more, depending on evidence and liability.



This document establishes the standards for a baseline program for the control and prevention of foreign object debris (FOD) and the resulting foreign object damage (FOD) caused by this debris.



When an object ends up in your food that doesn't belong there, like pieces of plastic or glass, pieces of metal, nails, hairpins, band-aids, or any other foreign object, you may be injured from chewing or ...
