Only 17% of the population of Guinea has access to electricity while over 96% of the population lacks access to clean cooking facilities.

The potential for hydroelectric power generation is high, but largely untapped. Electricity is not available to a high percentage of Guineans, especially in rural areas, and service is intermittent, even in the ...
