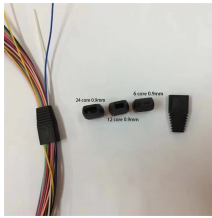

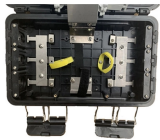
Without preparing cables and all the other stuff, so pure splicing, it takes less than a minute per splice. We often do 192f cables in around 4-5 hours from prep to finish.
