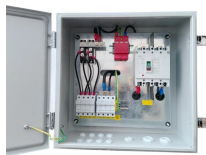

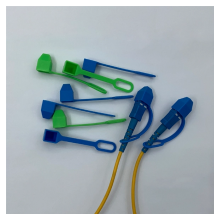
A fiber optic switch is a device that allows optical signals to be selectively switched from one optical fiber to another. It is essentially a switch that operates at the optical layer of a network, ...
