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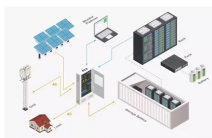

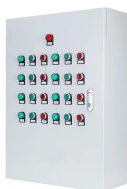

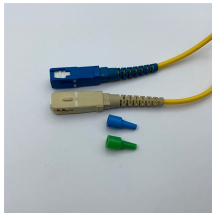
Rung spacing specified in the tray straight sections does not necessarily apply to fittings. Smooth radius fittings are compact and the curved rail shape is an aid for cable pulling. Factory engineering support ...



Several types of cable tray bends are available, each serving a specific purpose. Horizontal bends, also known as elbows, are used to change the direction of cables horizontally. They are commonly ...



NEMA V2 states that a radius must be supported in the center of the radius and within 2" of each end where the factory bend splices to the next straight section.



For non-horizontal runs, cables should be fastened securely to transverse members of the cable tray. Supports must be provided to prevent ...



For example, if we have to make a field bend for a 12" (300mm) metallic ladder tray using straight sections of this tray, then how much should be the minimum radius of this field bend?



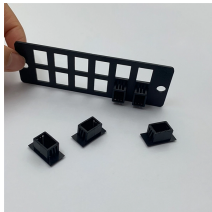
