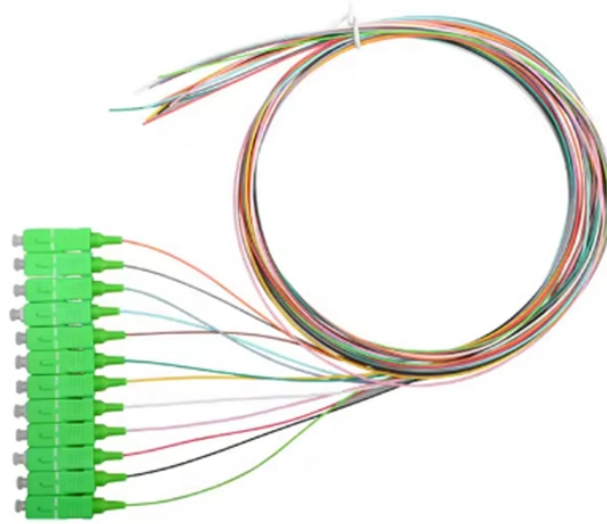

Each level of cable tray is supported by a trapeze consisting of unistrut and 1/2" threaded rod. The unistrut, cable tray and rod appear to have been spec'd with corrosion resistance in mind.



When several levels of cable ladder or cable tray are mounted on the same threaded rods in a multiple level installation, it is important to ensure that the total load on any pair of rods does not exceed the ...



) At support points, threaded rod must be hung from concrete inserts, clamps or devices that are securely fastened into the slab, wall or beam sufficiently to carry the load of the tray and its contents ...
