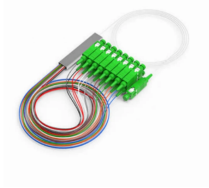

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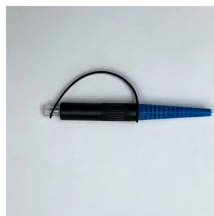
Electrician performs bulk tinning by dipping twisted copper conductors into a molten solder crucible to eliminate oxidation and maximize conductivity.

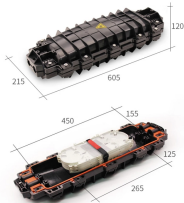
