

## Is testing mandatory when installing fiber optic cables

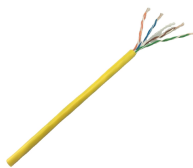

After the cables are installed and terminated, it's time for testing. For every fiber optic cable plant, you will need to test for continuity, end-to-end loss and then troubleshoot the problems.

The type of fiber optic cable is required to be positively identified by jacket markings and, if hybrid, the type of each fiber, since multimode and singlemode fiber are also terminated in a different manner.



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You must follow mandatory test protocols to protect your fiber optic network and meet legal requirements. These protocols come from both industry standards and local regulations.



Ensure that all components and parts have been received, match quantities ordered (e.g. fiber optic cable contains the number and type of fiber ordered and is the length ordered), and that any ...

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
