

Notice Regarding Underground Cable Relocation



Overview

The purpose of this chapter is to provide guidelines to the Local Public Agency (LPA) when performing R/W utility relocations on projects outside of the State Highway System (SHS) and financed with federal funds. (Source: CPUC Undergrounding Programs Description (ca. Rule 20 Program How do cities participate in Overhead Conversion Program?)

Is it the utility or the city that determines whether a city needs to convert overhead lines?

For Rule 20 Program, Cities identify overhead lines that they wish. If a power line is in the way of your project, here's how to request a relocation, what it costs, and what to do if the utility says no. Property owners can request that a power company relocate a line, but the process is formal, slow, and expensive. It will also identify and illustrate models used for planning a conversion program, and suggest how utilities, city and county governments, developers, residents, and businesses can work. The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Rule 20 sets policies and procedures for the conversion

of overhead power lines and other equipment to underground facilities, a process called "undergrounding. Utility relocations are required on most transportation projects. You're definitely in the right place to get a ticket submitted to have your local maintenance.
