

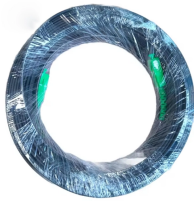
Optical Cable Termination Joint Butterfly Optical Cable



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Fiber joints are permanent or removable connections between multimode or single-mode fiber ends. Coupling losses depend substantially on the used technology.



To terminate an optical fiber cable in the field, the fiber (either tight-buffered or loose fan-out tube) is simply stripped, cleaved, inserted into the connector and mechanically secured.



Fiber optic joints or terminations are made two ways: 1) splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers or 2) connectors that mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the ...
