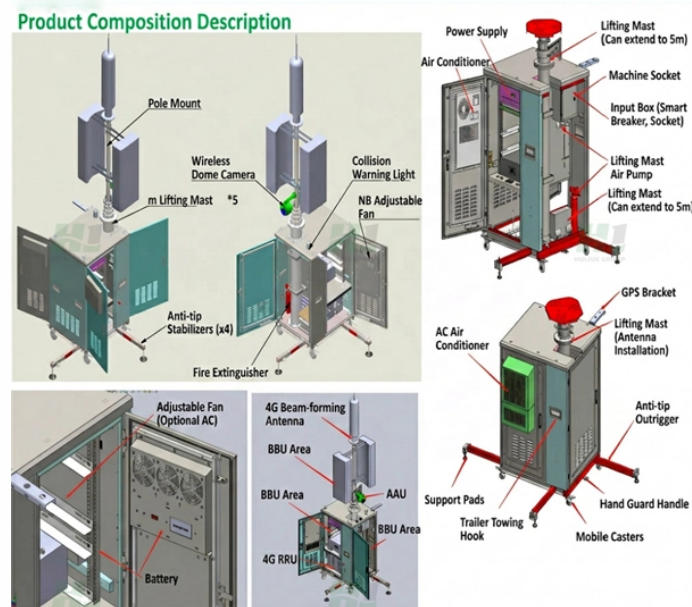


The Relationship Between Network Patch Panels and Fiber Optics

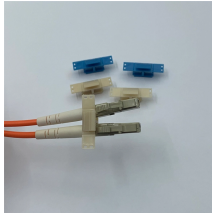

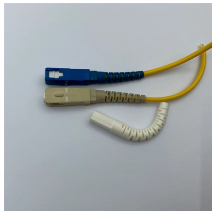
