Multimode fiber works well for short to medium distances, providing scalable capacity and cost-effective deployment for data centers, office buildings, and campuses. This intricate design allows for the transmission of data via light signals at incredibly high speeds. There are five main types of multimode fiber, standardized by ISO/IEC 11801: OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4 and OM5.
