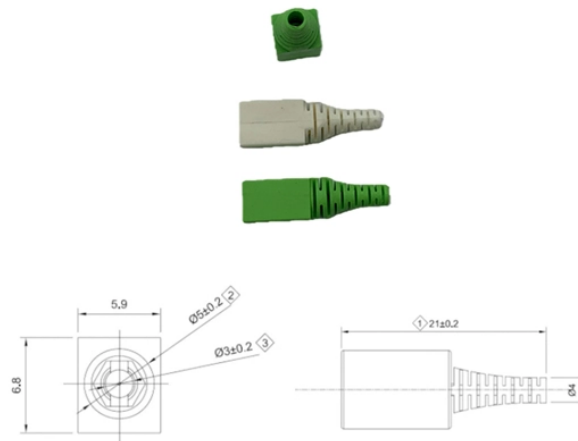


# White line of telecommunications fiber optic cable

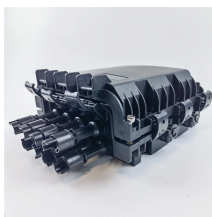

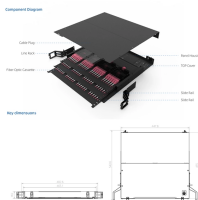
