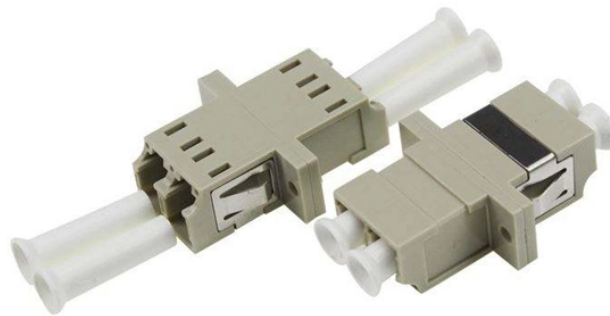


Why does the core switch restart



Overview

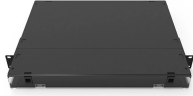

Unless you have a restart scripted for some reason it's likely you ran into an uptime bug on the box. Check your version as recommended. And if you are behind you should update this switch.

If the switch has reboot unexpectedly (in other words, you can see the console output after booting), it means this event is not triggered by the power monitor.

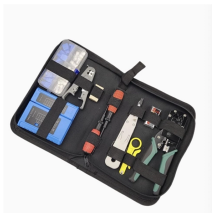

Bypass all switches and connect your PC directly to the Core. If the problem started after adding new items to the design, upgrade the Core to the latest firmware.
